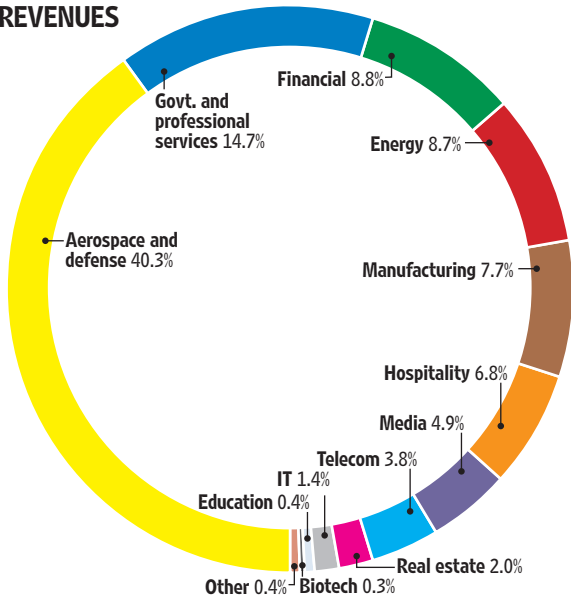

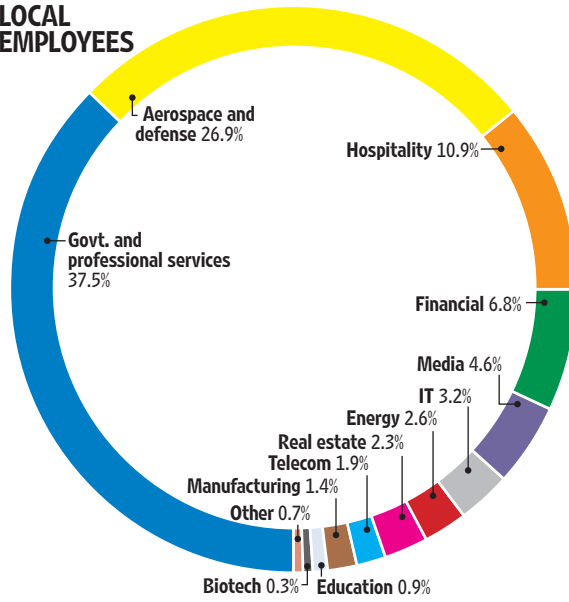

by percent of the total revenues, employees and market capitalization of all 81 companies.

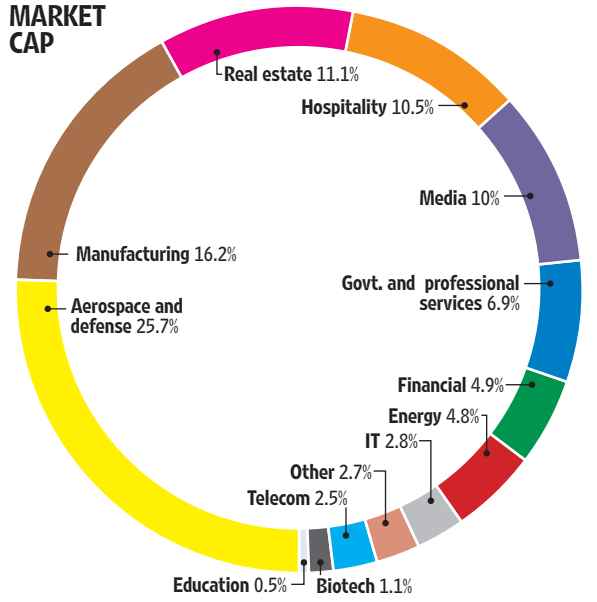
