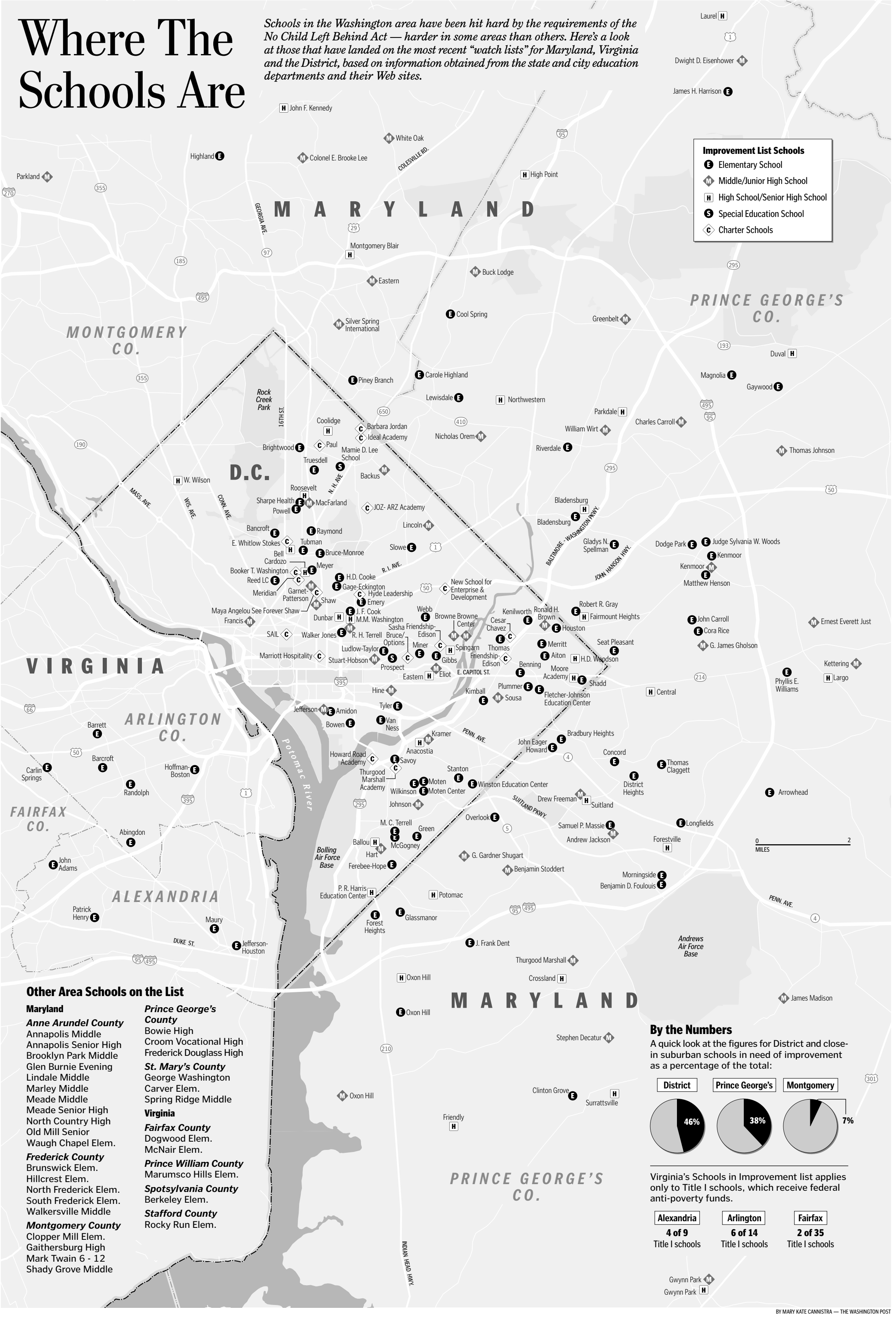


Where The Schools Are

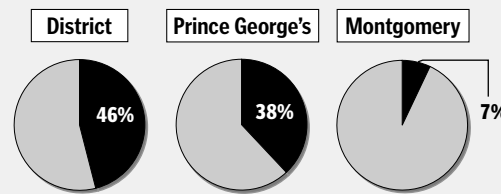
