JOINT STATEMENT FROM SENATOR JOHN WARNER AND REP. FRANK WOLF
CONCERNING ROUTE 50 TRAFFIC CALMING PROJECT

Washington, D.C. - Senator John Warner and Rep. Frank Wolf issued the following statement today concerning the Route 50 traffic calming project:

"We were asked by the citizens who live along the route, and who travel the road on a regular basis, to work to improve traffic flow and safety along the corridor. We pledged our support for this project nearly 10 years ago and remain committed to it, as the needs for safety improvements and congestion relief have grown in importance since our initial commitment. We applaud the citizen participation in the task force that has worked tirelessly with VDOT to design a plan that improves traffic flow while enhancing the communities along the corridor and improving safety. Our efforts in the recently enacted highway bill provide \$8 million specifically for improvements at Gilberts Corner, a major choke point along the corridor."
