NOTICE

Upon review of the submissions filed on November 16, 2009, it is apparent that the defendants failed to conform their post-hearing memorandum to the requirements of the Standing Order, entered in this case on January 7, 2009. Paragraph 1 of the Standing Order provides that all submissions “should be double-spaced, in 12-point Times Roman or Courier font.” In disregard of this provision, the defendants failed to double-space their memorandum, in an apparent attempt to include more information in their submission than would otherwise be permitted under the Standing Order. The court is loath to strike the defendants’ submission given the nature of the litigation and the proximity to trial. The parties, however, are put on notice that any further failure to meet the standards set by the court will result in sanctions.
