The defendant appeared this day and was led to the bar in the custody of the Sheriff of this City. He was represented by Rebecca Norris of the Public Defender's Office, and the Commonwealth was represented by Thomas Johnson. The defendant agreed to having these cases tried simultaneously.

Being arraigned, the defendant pled guilty to attempted rape as charged in Indictment - F-98-909, and guilty to sodomy as charged in Indictment F-98-908, after consultation with counsel.

Whereupon the Court inquired of the defendant if he had been advised of and fully understood the significance of his pleas of guilty, to which inquiry the defendant answered in the affirmative, and the Court accepted said pleas of guilty.

The evidence of the Commonwealth having been stipulated, there being no evidence presented on behalf of the defendant, and no arguments of counsel, the Court finds the defendant guilty of the following offenses:

The defendant, by counsel, having made a motion for a presentence investigation and report; the Court grants said motion and these cases are continued to July 22, 1998 at 9:00 a.m. for a presentence.

Pursuant to Section 19.2-310.2, it is Ordered that a sample of the defendant's blood be taken forthwith for DNA analysis.

Thereupon, the defendant was remanded.
