### **CORRECTION OF STATEMENT MADE CONCERNING THE MISSING PERSON CASE INVOLVING CHANDRA LEVY**

Today, an article appeared in the Washington Post newspaper concerning the investigation of the disappearance of Ms. Chandra Levy. A statement concerning the department's investigation was attributed to Assistant Chief of Police Ronald Monroe the commander of ROC North. Assistant Chief Monroe was stated as saying that Ms. Levy had visited Congressman Condit's apartment "more than a couple of times."

The department wishes to take this opportunity to clarify this statement. Assistant Chief Monroe indicated today that he apparently failed to make himself clear when making this statement to the Washington Post reporter. Assistant Chief Monroe now indicates that he was not confirming whether or not Ms. Levy had ever actually been to the apartment. However, he was confirming that the department was aware of this unsubstantiated rumor as it is aware of numerous other unsubstantiated rumors surrounding this investigation. At this time there is no concrete evidence to confirm these various rumors.

The department regrets any misunderstanding or embarrassment this matter may have caused. The department is continuing to investigate the various tips, leads and rumors that have surfaced during the onset of the investigation.
