7 RESULTS OF INVESTIGATION

ITEM On 5-14-01 at approximately 1900 hours Halle R. Shilling reported that she was the victim of an assault by an individual with a knife on the horse and foot trail in the area of Beach Dr. at Grove 4.

The description of the suspect is a:

Hispanic white male  
Medium brown complexion  
5'07" - 5'08" tall, thin build (approx. 155-165 lbs.,)  
approximately 17-18 years old  
Dark brown hair - medium length (wavy), Brown eyes, no facial hair, large cheek bones  
white T-shirt, blue nylon mesh shorts with a 1-inch solid white stripe down the sides

Shilling stated that she began jogging from her parked vehicle in the Pierce Mill parking lot at approximately 1830 hours. Shilling jogged north on the trail along Beach Dr. from Pierce Mill. Shilling was wearing a yellow SONY walk-man with headphones and was listening to music. Shilling jogged through Broad Branch Parking and observed the suspect (described above) watch her jog while he was sitting on the curb on the west side of the parking lot. Shilling continued jogging north on the trail adjacent to Beach Drive. While jogging, Shilling looked behind her and observed the suspect jogging behind her. Shilling continued jogging but slowed her pace to possibly allow the suspect to pass her. Shilling then looked behind her again and observed that the suspect kept the same distance. Shilling slowed again to allow the suspect to pass. Shilling then felt the suspect's arm grab her around the neck. Shilling then observed the suspect, who had his shirt off which was tucked into his shorts, grab her. The suspect also displayed a silver colored knife with a black handle. Shilling could not identify what type of knife it was. Shilling began to scream "No" several times. The suspect attempted to quiet Shilling but could not hear due to the headphones. Shilling was then pushed to the ground and began to struggle with the suspect. During the struggle, Shilling's walk-man and headphones were knocked off and fell to the ground. Shilling got back to her feet and began to push the suspect away. Shilling's right hand pushed the suspect's face. Shilling's right hand middle finger entered the suspect's mouth, at which time the suspect bit her. The suspect then let her go and began to run south. Shilling stated that she had been jogging for approximately 12-15 minutes before the attack.

Shilling ran north along the trail where she was assisted by two joggers at Rapids foot bridge. Shilling was then escorted by the joggers to the U.S. Park Police Rock Creek station.

At USPP D3, I assisted Shilling and asked if she needed medical attention. Shilling stated that besides her finger she was unhurt and did not request an Ambulance. The skin on the middle finger was not broken but had a small mark. I obtained look-out information, advised USPP Communications and directed USPP D3 units to the location of the incident with the description and direction of flight of the suspect. Car 202 - Sgt. Gott was advised of the situation. The USPP Eagle helicopter responded to the area. I then advised the responding units that the SONY walk-man may still be at location of the attack. The crime scene was located and USPP ID Unit responded. A check of the area was conducted by the USPP Eagle, cars 312, 313, 333, 314, car 202 and car 31 with negative result. K-9 8 also responded and conducted a track from the scene with negative results.

At USPP D3, Shilling completed a Complainant/Victim statement. Det. J. Green responded to USPP D3 and met with the victim. Det. Green, Shilling and I responded to the crime scene where Shilling described in detail her encounter with the suspect.

USPP ID Unit, Ofc. Simonello recovered the walk-man for a possible search for fingerprints. All units cleared the incident at approximately 2045 hours.

I issued Shilling a "Information for Victims and Witnesses of Crime" pamphlet along with my contact information and a telephone number for USPP Communications. I also issued Shilling a "Paths to Safety" pamphlet. Photos of Shilling's right hand were taken.

Shilling stated that she did not observe any other suspected individuals at Broad Branch Parking or at the crime scene.

Time cleared at approximately 2330 hours.
