VIETNAM VETERANS AGAINST THE WAR (VVAW) REGIONAL COORDINATORS AND  
 NATIONAL STEERING COMMITTEE MEETING WEEKEND NOVEMBER FOURTEEN, NINETEEN  
 SEVENTYONE, KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, IS - NEW LEFT. OO [redacted]

A CONFIDENTIAL SOURCE, WHO HAS FURNISHED RELIABLE INFORMATION IN  
 THE PAST, ADVISED AS FOLLOWS THIS DATE: CAPTIONED MEETING WAS HELD  
 IN KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, OVER THE WEEKEND OF NOVEMBER FOURTEEN,  
 NINETEEN SEVENTYONE, BEGINNING FRIDAY NOON, NOVEMBER TWELVE,  
 NINETEEN SEVENTYONE. THE FIRST SESSION MEETING, WHICH WAS A CLOSED  
 SESSION, WAS HELD AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSOURI AT KANSAS CITY,  
 MISSOURI (UMKC). APPROXIMATELY FIFTY INDIVIDUALS ATTENDED THE FIRST  
 SESSION WITH THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL VVAW EXECUTIVE  
 COMMITTEE PRESENT: AL HUBBARD; JOHN KERRY; MIKE OLIVER; BRYAN ADAMS  
 MEETING CHAIRMAN: SKIP ROBERTS. ALL MEMBERS OF THE STEERING COM-  
 MITTEE, WHICH CONSISTS OF TWENTYSIX REGIONAL COORDINATORS, WERE  
 PRESENT. OTHER INDIVIDUALS PRESENT WERE STATE COORDINATORS. THE

FRIDAY MEETING DID NOT START UNTIL FOUR THIRTY P. M. AND NO BUSINESS OF CONSEQUENCE WAS CONDUCTED. JOHN KERRY MENTIONED ON FRIDAY THAT HE WAS GOING TO RESIGN HIS POSITION ON THE NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE BECAUSE OF POLITICS AND KERRY ATTEMPTED TO GET AL HUBBARD VOTED OUT OF THE EXECUTIVE MEETING. FRIDAY'S SESSION ENDED AT NINE P.M.

THE MEETING CONTINUED ON SATURDAY AT APPROXIMATELY NINE A. M. AT NUMBER TWO WEST FORTIETH STREET, KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI, WITH THE SAME PEOPLE PRESENT AND WAS ANOTHER CLOSED SESSION. JOHN KERRY AGAIN ATTEMPTED TO HAVE AL HUBBARD VOTED OFF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE AS KERRY STATED HE DID NOT THINK HUBBARD EVER SERVED IN VIETNAM OR WAS EVER IN SERVICE. DURING THE SATURDAY SESSION, HUBBARD GAVE A SUMMARY OF HIS TALKS IN PARIS WITH OFFICIALS OF DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF VIETNAM (DRV) AND PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC GOVERNMENT (PHONETIC) (PRG). HUBBARD ADVISED HE HAD JUST RETURNED FROM A MEETING IN PARIS AFTER THE ABOVE ORGANIZATIONS HAD INVITED REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE FOLLOWING ORGANIZATIONS: VVAW, COMMUNIST PARTY (CP) USA, AND LEFT WING GROUP IN PARIS, NAME UNRECALLED.

MUSSARD ADVISED HE WAS ELECTED BY THE VVAV TO ATTEND AND AN UNKNOWN INDIVIDUAL REPRESENTED THE CP USA AND HIS TRIP WAS FINANCED BY THE CP USA. MUSSARD ADVISED A FEMALE INDIVIDUAL NAMED [REDACTED] *France* WAS LIAISON BETWEEN THE DRV AND PRO AND THE INDIVIDUALS INVITED. HE ADVISED THAT [REDACTED] AS FAR AS HE KNEW, LIVED IN PARIS AND WAS A FRIEND TO THE INVITING PARTIES. MUSSARD ADVISED THAT WHILE IN PARIS, HE MET WITH QUANTREE FOR THE REPUBLIC OF NORTH VIETNAM AND OTHERS. THEY TALKED ABOUT POW ISSUES AND THE POSSIBILITY OF A VVAV DELEGATION TO GO TO NORTH VIETNAM IN THE FUTURE. MUSSARD STAYED FOR APPROXIMATELY ONE WEEK BEFORE RETURNING TO THE USA. ANOTHER INDIVIDUAL ATTENDING THE CAPTIONED MEETING WAS JOE URGO, *Vietnam Personal* IDENTIFIED AS AN EMPLOYEE *me* OUT OF THE NATIONAL VVAV OFFICE. URGO ADVISED AT THE MEETING THAT HE WENT TO HANOI IN AUGUST NINETEEN SEVENTYONE, AND TALKED WITH NORTH VIETNAM OFFICERS. HE DESCRIBED HIS CONFERENCE TIED IN WITH THE INTERNATIONAL ACTION OF ACTIVE DUTY U.S. PERSONNEL TO DEMONSTRATE AGAINST THE WAR. TWO PROPOSALS MADE BY URGO TO THE NORTH VIETNAMESE WERE AS FOLLOWS: ONE ) TAPES TO BE MADE BY THE VVAV TO BE BROADCAST OVER RADIO HANOI TO GET U.S. SOLDIERS TO STOP FIGHTING; TWO) TO SEND A VVAV DELEGATION TO HANOI IN THE NEAR FUTURE. *U*

SEVERAL PROPOSALS WERE MADE FOR FUTURE ACTION IN CAPTIONED MEETING: AND THE PROPOSALS VOTED ON TO TAKE PLACE WERE AS FOLLOWS; FIVE CITIES WERE DESIGNATED IN THE UNITED STATES TO DIVIDE UP ALL THE WVAW REGIONS AND A VARIETY OF ACTIONS WERE TO TAKE PLACE AT EACH CITY, INCLUDING MARCHES, RODEO THEATERS, BLOOD GIVING CEREMONIES AND OTHER DIFFERENT ACTIVITIES IN CERTAIN AREAS. IN ALL FIVE AREAS THERE MOST LIKELY WILL BE CIVIL DISOBEDIENCE. THE ABOVE ACTIVITY IS TO TAKE PLACE BETWEEN DECEMBER TWENTYFOUR, NINETEEN SEVENTYONE, AND JANUARY FIRST, NINETEEN SEVENTYTWO, IN THE FOLLOWING CITIES; KILLEEN, TEXAS; CHICAGO, ILLINOIS; VALLEY FORGE, PENNSYLVANIA; ATLANTA, GEORGIA; AND SAN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA.

ANOTHER PROPOSAL VOTED INCLUDED ACTIVITY TO TAKE PLACE ON THANKSGIVING DAY AT EACH STATE CAPITOL IN THE UNITED STATES CONSISTING OF A VIGIL AND FEAST IN MEMORY OF THE MILLIONS OF VICTIMS OF THE INDO-CHINA WAR.

CAPTIONED MEETINGS WERE HELD AGAIN ON SUNDAY AND MONDAY BUT ONLY ADMINISTRATIVE BUSINESS AND OTHER GENERALITIES WERE DISCUSSED. THE MEETINGS ENDED AT TWELVE NOON.
