Dear Ms. Grant:

During the eleven (11) months of services, we have been able to sustain a successful program at a cost of less than we budgeted for and at 30% more than the grantor provided (see close-out documents). Lurn-N-Ern is unable at this point to continue to absorb these costs and provide the high level of services required to meet the needs of the target population.

The targeted population requires more services than were defined in the contract, i.e., emergency counseling as it relates to their HIV/AIDS health status, constant supervision of clients who have mental health problems and who do not take their medication and supervision of clients who have stolen needed program and company items (laptop, food).

The grant agreement for October 1, 2005 through September 30, 2006 has ended and Lurn-N-Ern, have decided not to renew Grant #7Q0339. Please disregard the budget submitted on 10/16/06.

There are four (4) clients currently enrolled with Lurn-N-Ern who will have to be referred back to the Centralized Housing Intake and Assessment Agency/Gatekeeper to facilitate their housing needs.

We thank you for the opportunity to provide a needed service to ward 7 and will cooperate with you to transition the current clients.
