## FIRST DOWN

### Ball Security

Fourth-year QB Jason Campbell has played at the highest level of his career in leading the Redskins (3-1) to a surprising start, including last week's victory over Dallas at Texas Stadium. Campbell — who has no turnovers — has made correct decisions and big plays. He'll need to continue that trend against one of the most aggressive defenses in the league.



## SECOND DOWN

### Control the Clock

The Redskins, who have five interceptions and two fumble recoveries, are tied for the NFL lead with a plus-six turnover ratio. Being sure-handed has enabled Washington to control the clock to this point, averaging nearly a five-minute advantage in time of possession. In last week's victory over Dallas, Washington had a nearly 17-minute edge.



## THIRD DOWN

### More Moss

WR Santana Moss, slowed because of numerous injuries the previous two seasons, appears to be physically sound again. Moss, Campbell's favorite target, ranks second in the league with 421 yards receiving and is tied for third with 27 receptions. And most important for the Redskins, Moss again is a top deep threat, but he'll be facing one of the best secondaries.



## FOURTH DOWN

### Waiting on Westbrook

The Redskins will catch a major break if Eagles RB Brian Westbrook doesn't play. The former DeMatha star strained his right ankle in a Week 3 victory over Pittsburgh. The Eagles have a history of playing down injuries under Coach Andy Reid, and some league observers believe Westbrook's ankle problem is more serious. Even if Westbrook plays, he could be limited.

## THE ZORN ZONE | FIRST-YEAR COACH JIM ZORN'S TAKE ON THE EAGLES

Eagles defensive coordinator Jim Johnson usually prefers to blitz a lot, so the Redskins must execute well in pass protection and be sharp in their line adjustments, Zorn said.

"This will be one of the first teams we've faced that will heavily blitz their secondary," he said. "They'll bring their safeties, they've brought a corner blitz before, so they don't mind getting in the mix with their safeties. And then their linebackers are some of the best blitzing linebackers that we've seen."

Running back Clinton Portis had his first 100-yard game of the season in the victory over the Cowboys, but the Eagles give up 2.6 yards per rush — fewest in the NFL.

"This defense has only allowed 53 yards average per team that they've played," Zorn said. "They're very stingy about allowing a running back to run, so we've got to pick our times. We have to be right on target with who we're blocking, how we're blocking 'em."

Although they are coming off a big road victory over Dallas and have played well, the Redskins have a long way to go before being pleased with their season, Zorn said.

"We haven't accomplished any of our goals yet. All of our goals are ahead of us," he said. "The only goal we've attained is that we've actually won more games than we've lost. We just won our last game. A lot of other teams have done the same thing. We shouldn't feel like, 'Gosh, we're the crowning glory.'"
