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**EXPUNGEMENT ORDER**

THIS MATTER having been opened to the Court upon the Verified Petition and Affidavit of Sean A. Ringgold whose date of birth is November 3, 1977 and it appearing that the requirements for expungement under *N.J.S.A. 2C:52-1*, et seq. have been satisfied;

IT IS ORDERED this 19 day of October, 2016 that the 1) Attorney General, State of New Jersey; 2) Superintendent, New Jersey State Police, Expungement Unit; 3) Hudson County Prosecutor; 4) Clerk, Municipal Court of Secaucus; 5) Chief, Secaucus Police Department; 6) Hudson County Probation Office; 7) Hudson County Identification Bureau; and 8) Division of Criminal Justice, Records & Identification Unit; remove from their records all information relating to the July 2, 2013 arrest of Sean A. Ringgold in Secaucus, New Jersey; Indictment No. 2245-12-2013, Complex A W-2013-000400-0909 charged with Criminal Sexual Contact, in violation of N.J.S.A. NJS 2C:14-3b and all proceedings Dismissed Sept. 30, 2014 regarding such charges, including any convictions, if applicable, and place such information in the control of a person within the office designated to retain control over expunged records, and it is further

ORDERED that any of the above officers or agencies which sent fingerprints and/or any records of the above conviction and proceedings to the Federal Bureau of Investigation or any other office or agency shall notify same of this Order and that the agencies designated to retain


such records take sufficient precautions to insure that such records and information are not released, and it is further

ORDERED that any records, or the information therein, shall not be released except as provided under the provision of N.J.S.A. 2C:52-1, et seq. and that the persons designated to retain control over expunged records take sufficient precautions to insure that such records and information are not released, and it is further

ORDERED that in response to requests for information or records, the court office or the law enforcement agency shall reply with respect to the conviction, which is subject of this Order, that there is no record, and it is further


ORDERED that the arrest and/or conviction which is the subject of this Order shall be deemed, in contemplation of law, not to have occurred, and the Petitioner may answer accordingly any question relating to its occurrence except as provided in N.J.S.A. 2C:52-27; and it is further

ORDERED that this Order does not expunge the records contained in the Controlled Dangerous Registry created pursuant to P.L. 1970, c.227 (C.26:2G-17 et seq.) or the registry created by the Administrative Office of the Courts pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2C:43-21.
