That's the number of electoral votes a candidate needs to win the presidency. As you watch election results Tuesday, you can keep track of who is winning the electoral-vote race. When a candidate wins a state, write that number of electoral votes in his column next to that state. For example, if Mitt Romney wins Utah, write "6" next to Utah in Romney's column. It's a race: First one to 270 wins!
